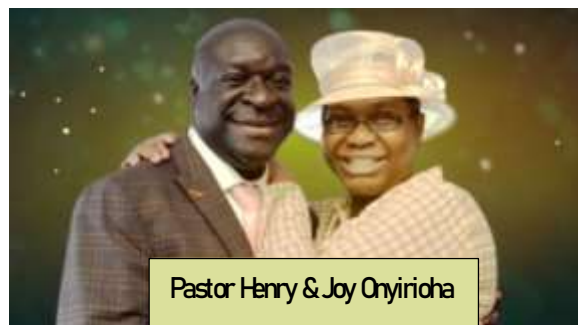

Dinner at Emmaus

Happy Easter!

As we celebrate the risen King, journey with us for 'dinner at Emmaus'. Two disciples who travelled to Emmaus with the risen Jesus, only recognised Him when He broke bread with them at dinner (Luke 24:13 – 35). On the way, the two disciples asked questions about Jesus, to which Jesus Himself provided answers that gave them better understanding, but were still blinded spiritually.

Like the two disciples, when you seek a better understanding of God or a deeper relationship with God, you travel with Jesus. You however need to progress to dine with Him, to know Him and experience the Hope, Salvation, transformation and Victory He offers; for the disciples purportedly partook of His broken body on the cross during dinner at Emmaus and were spiritually awakened. How are you engaging with Jesus? PPN Programmes are designed to help you engage, and then experience Jesus! After your experience, please, share your testimony, just as the two disciples went to Jerusalem to tell other disciples.
