Prayer Power Network (PPN) is committed to helping members discover their God-given purpose through a vibrant prayer life. Our prayer altar must therefore remain on fire. We ought to pray without ceasing (1 Thessalonians 5:17). Not necessarily all bowed praying all day, but living with a conscious awareness of His presence, building a relationship and continual communion with God.

#### Prayer as First Response and Master Key

When prayer becomes a lifestyle, it becomes our first response in challenging times. Philippians 4:6 urges us to present everything to God in prayer. Jesus said, "Whatever you ask in my name, I will do it" (John 14:13-14). Prayer is not a duty, but a privilege. It is the master key that unlocks heaven.

#### Helping People Become Fervent in Prayer

PPN is a prayer school. Members are groomed to be fervent in prayer because the effectual fervent prayer of the righteous avails much (James 5:16).

We hold prayers from 9pm to 10 pm UK Time daily, except on Sundays when it is held from 5pm to 6 pm due to the Sunday Charge. Prayers are made for PPN, her members and leaders. Intercession is also made for other people and for our nations. A Rota ensures every worker leads prayers at least once a month. We also hold a Monthly prayer chain on the first Friday of the month.

As the Prayer Coordinator for PPN, I thank God for the privilege and I appreciate Pastor Henry for this opportunity. I also thank every worker who consistently shows up.
