It has been raining blessings in September to Remember. In confirmation of the theme (Call His name; See His power), God has been revealing His names to us and telling us what powerful things He can do, when we call on His name. And indeed, each night, we see the power of God in instant miracles and in diverse dimensions.

The event had a powerful and illuminating start with Evangelist Ikechukwu Peter, who explained the name of Jesus.

In **Day 1**, we learnt about the implication of Jesus as our High priest (Hebrews 2:17). With an authorization from Jesus, the High Priest, we can transform our desires into reality and recover what satan has stolen. (Luke 10.19).

“There are certain things you will never achieve in life, if you don’t have the relevant authorization.”

In **Day 2**, he explained that in the old testament, God was named according to His actions. The more of God’s name you know, the more of God you manifested. Praise God, in this new testament, we have a better covenant.

All the names of God, from Almighty, to Jehovah, are now encapsulated in the one name of JESUS (Colossians 1:19-21). This means Jesus is the collection of all the characteristics, power, riches and names of God. The name is not just a nomenclature. It is a place, a possession and a position.

September to Remember 36 Days of Rain

Place / Location (1 Corinthians 5:4-5, Proverbs 18:10, Matthew 18:20). The name of Jesus is a spiritual atmosphere, or a spirit city we can enter into. And as we meet in His name, we have the authority to judge satan (Luke 10.19).

Possession (Acts 3:6). “There is what you have in His name.”
“Until you identify what you have, what you need cannot come to you.”

Position (Philippians 2:8-11). The name of Jesus is an exalted name. The position is the authority. When that name shows up, other things bow.

Question 1: Are you in the place called that name?

“Those who are not in the name cannot possess the name. And those who have not possessed the name, cannot use the position of that name”

Question 2: If the fullness of God is in that name JESUS, what do you want, that the name cannot provide?
