Excerpts from PPN Post-Birmingham 2025 Sunday Charge by Dr. Joseph Oluwadebi on August 10, 2025

Thank God for the glorious success of Birmingham 2025! We prepared, prayed, encountered God, and received blessings. But, that's not enough. We must maintain the blessings.

In Luke 9:28–36, Peter experienced the glory of the transfiguration and wanted to remain there. But Jesus led them down to continue the mission. Likewise, we cannot stay at Birmingham 2025; but must continue to work, to sustain the power received.

In 1 Timothy 6:20, we are charged with the responsibility to keep that which is committed to our trust. To do this, we need to embrace three keys:

1. **Holiness** – Walking in righteousness keeps the blessing flowing. In John 5:14, Jesus told the man he healed at the pool of Bethesda, to sin no more.
2. **Faith & Prayer** – Like the Shunammite woman (2 Kings 4:19–26), unwavering faith and prayer revive miracles and keep the fire alive.
3. **Thanksgiving** – God delights in gratitude (Psalm 107:15–16). Of the ten lepers healed in Luke 17, only one, who returned to thank Jesus, was made whole.

Beloved, the River of Mercy is still flowing! Keep the fire burning through holiness, faith, with prayer and thanksgiving, and watch God perfect all that concerns you.
